Fitting Instructions



Application

Step 1. Unfasten all Velcro straps and apply seated with the knee bent. Position the patella pad on the knee cap and align the hinges with the center of the knee joint.

Step 2. Fasten the calf strap first (this strap prevents slipping) and then the top strap. Fasten the popliteal strap. If slipping occurs, check that the calf strap is above the largest part of the calf muscle and tightened securely.
